Dear Doug,

On April 30, 2011, Region 49's first filing window for 700 MHz permanent license applications closed.

Of the six applications we received, three indicate that their predicted 5 dBu co-channel interference contours extend into Region 51's area. These applications were submitted by Fayette County and the Brazos Valley Council of Governments (separate applications for sites in Brazos and Washington Counties).

As you know, the Brazos and Washington County sites are currently operational on the same frequencies as requested on their applications under STAs, call signs WQLD479 and WQLD480, which expire on August 30, 2011.

In accordance with the *Inter-Regional Coordination Procedures and Procedures for Resolution of Disputes That May Arise Under FCC Approved Plans* between our Regions signed on August 29, 2006, I am requesting your review and letters of concurrence for these three applications. Since I am not certain that the CAPRAD process for these interregional requests and notifications is currently working, please accept this request by e-mail. I have attached the three application files; they are also available on the Region 49 web site (www.Region49.org) and on the Region 49 700 MHz applications section of CAPRAD.
