



Resolution

WHEREAS, the week of April 6-11, 2015, has been designated as National Community Development Week by the National Community Development Association to celebrate the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Program provides annual funding and flexibility to local communities to provide decent, safe affordable housing, a suitable living environment, and economic opportunities to low- and moderate-income people; and

WHEREAS, nationally, over one million units of affordable housing have been completed using HOME funds; and

WHEREAS, over the past five years, Harris County has received a total \$55,808,101.00 in CDBG funds and \$13,599,614.00 in HOME funds; and


WHEREAS, over the past five years, Harris County CDBG and HOME funds have been used to fund the completion of the following: 34 public facility projects and 101 infrastructure projects benefiting more than 165,000 Harris County residents; 120 nuisance properties cleared; 541 homebuyers and 321 homeowners assisted; 184 multi-family affordable housing units and 46 single family homes constructed; 842 homeless persons assisted with supportive services; and 33,531 seniors, youth and low-income persons assisted with general public services: now, therefore

National Community Development Week

in Harris County, Texas, and offers congratulations on these successes.
