ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AMENDMENTS
PUBLIC NOTICE

July 11, 2016

The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that Harris County develop a 3- to 5-year strategy document which states the community development and housing needs of the jurisdiction and annually submits, in a single application for funding, its request for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds. Other funding addressed includes Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) I and III and Community Development Block Grant – Disaster (CDBG-D) funds. This strategy document is called the Consolidated Plan, and the single application for funding is called the Annual Action Plan (AAP). When significant changes occur to the Consolidated Plan and subsequent AAPs, Harris County must propose amendments to be reviewed by the public for a 30-day comment period. The Harris County Community Services Department (HCCSD) proposes the following amendment:

2016 ESG Funding:

Project C2016-0033e The Salvation Army Houston Area Command Social Services – Rapid Re-Housing for Young Adults (Countywide). *Project Scope Change* – Current Scope: Grantee proposes to deliver housing relocation and stabilization services to sixty (60) young-adult households referred through Coordinated Access and move them from homelessness to permanent supportive housing. Case managers will provide housing stability case management to ensure an end to client homelessness and intensive case management and supportive services to include links to mainstream services. Revised Scope: Grantee proposes to deliver housing relocation and housing stabilization services to sixty (60) young-adult households referred through Coordinated Access and move them from homelessness or a precariously-housed situation to permanent housing. Once housed, case managers will provide housing stability case management to ensure an end to client homelessness and intensive case management and supportive services including links to mainstream services. Total project funding, including previously awarded amounts, remains unchanged at \$190,953.00.
