Harris County has initiated the Program Year 2015, March 1, 2015 through February 28, 2016 RFP process for community development, homeless, and housing projects. Through the competitive RFP application process, this department is responsible for distributing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program funds.

The Harris County service area includes the unincorporated portions of Harris County and cities that have signed a cooperative agreement with the County.
