








What is Wraparound?

- Wraparound is a treatment planning *process* as opposed to a single intervention for a specific problem
- The goal is to ensure that the individual is adequately supported by their community through the coordination of multi-agency services
- Wraparound can be used for any treatment planning process, however, for SOH, the focus is on children with serious emotional and behavioral problems and their families




Systems of Care and Wraparound

- SOC is closely aligned with Wraparound because they share similar principles
 - Family driven and youth guided
 - Community-based services
 - Culturally and linguistically competent
 - Individualized



Wraparound Fidelity Index (WFI)


- WFI measures adherence to wraparound principles
- Conducted as structured phone interview
- Responses are gathered from the caregiver, the youth, care coordinator, and/or another team member identified by the family



Scoring WFI

- Data is entered into an online database for analysis
- Scores are summed to create total scores
- These scores are converted into percentages


80%>	Above Average Fidelity
75 - 79%	Average Fidelity
70 - 74%	Below Average Fidelity
<70%	Non-Wraparound



Systems of Hope

Wraparound Fidelity Index

- First WFI data collection May 2010; initial results were presented at the November 2010 Governing Board Meeting
- Second round data collection began May 2011
- The data presented here provides a comparison between baseline and one year follow-up




Wraparound Fidelity Index

Respondent Role	Number of Interviews 2010	Number of Interviews 2011
Caregivers	14	22
Facilitators	8	18
Youth	12	7
Team Member	9	11
Total	43	58


Harris County WFI Scores by Role




WFI Scores by Principle




WFI Scores by Principle





Conclusion

- Overall, SOH scores by role have increased dramatically – all scores are considered above average fidelity
- 9 out of 10 (90%) WFI scores by principle have increased to at least average fidelity to Wraparound principles
- SOH leads national average in adherence to Wraparound principles



Data Flash



Green Light (Good news):


- Overall SOH fidelity scores increased across all principles and for all roles
- SOH leads national averages in all categories
- SOH does not have any scores that would be considered non-Wraparound

Yellow Light (Caution/ Monitor):


- The Natural Supports principle has increased from non-Wraparound to Below Average Fidelity.

Red Light (Concern):

- None at this time
