Dear Counselors:

Please give this scholarship information to your interested graduating seniors. Constable May Walker, Harris County Precinct 7, will award two (2) four-year scholarships to seniors with a C or better grade point average. This will be a four-year academic scholarship, which includes tuition and books paid directly to the university. The scholarship will provide tuition for each student starting the Fall of 2009 and ending Fall of 2012. It will not include summer sessions.

The scholarships are intended to provide assistance to two students who have expressed an interest in a career in Criminal Justice and Law Enforcement.

Application Guidelines:

- The applicant must live in and attend a high school located within the Precinct 7 jurisdiction.
- Student must graduate from high school in the Spring Semester of 2009.
- Student's field of study (major): Criminal Justice.
- Student will be required to write a brief essay of 150 words or more describing his/her educational goals and how the Precinct 7 Scholarship will provide an educational opportunity for him/her.
- A Texas funded college or university must accept student and student must enroll before the scholarship is awarded (copy of acceptance letter).
- Student must obtain a copy of transcript of 9th – 12th grade (1st semester of 12th grade required).
- Two (2) letters of recommendation: teacher, principal, counselor, or employer.
- Financial checklist.
- Work experience.
- Signed application
- Mail, email, fax or hand deliver completed application to Precinct 7 Contact, Pamela Greenwood by Monday, June 8th.
- Late applications will not be considered.
