**ORDER**


In recognition of extreme interest in this matter, the nature of the allegations being considered, and to ensure the fair, orderly administration of justice in this case and in other cases currently before our sister courts in the Harris County Civil Courthouse, the Court finds it necessary to issue the following **ORDER**:

1. This matter will be heard in the 164<sup>th</sup> Civil Courtroom in the Harris County Civil Courthouse. The Courtroom is located on the 12<sup>th</sup> Floor of the Civil Courthouse.
2. After proceedings commence, all spectators and media representatives present in the courtroom shall be seated and shall not stand in the back of the Courtroom. No one shall be permitted to enter or exit the courtroom. No one shall be permitted to enter or exit the courtroom while proceedings are in progress.
3. No cameras, sound recording, or sound transmission equipment of any type will be permitted inside of the 164<sup>th</sup> Civil Courtroom in the Harris County Civil Courthouse, and/or during any proceeding in this matter.
4. Members of the media are permitted to use cameras, sound recording, or sound transmission equipment of any type in the ante chamber of the courtroom, **only**. Cameras may shoot through the windows in the ante chamber of the Courtroom, **only**.
5. After proceedings are concluded, all spectators and media representatives shall immediately leave the Courtroom.
6. Members of the public and media personnel outside the courtroom shall not create distractions and shall avoid restricting movement of persons passing through the halls and / or the doors to the courtroom.

7. Any person having notice of this Order who violates it shall be subject to the Court's contempt power.
8. If an employee of a media organization or company violates this Order, they shall be subject to immediate expulsion from the Harris County Civil Courthouse.
9. All persons employed by a media organization, company or entity shall be presumed to have notice of all the provisions of this Order.

This Court shall entertain reasonable requests to modify this Order as the need arises.
