**Temporary Restraining Order**

The State of Texas (State) applied for a Temporary Restraining Order against the Defendants, Golden Star Business, LLC, et al. After considering the State's application for a temporary restraining order against all defendants, as well as the pleadings and affidavits, the court FINDS as follows:

1. The State will suffer the following immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage: interference with the public health, safety, peace, comfort, and convenience of its citizens – caused by the defendants' operation of an illegal gambling place. Issuance of a temporary restraining order will not adversely affect the public interest and public policy because this game room, by its manner of use, is unlawful.
2. This injury is irreparable because this game room, by its manner of use, is unlawful. Patrons who accept payouts are misdemeanants. The persons who operate the gambling place are engaged in organized criminal activity. Threatened harm to the citizens outweighs any harm this temporary injunction will inflict upon the defendants. Issuance of a temporary restraining order would not adversely affect the public interest and public policy.
3. This ex parte order is granted without notice to defendants, because the State will suffer immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage if the TRO is not granted before defendant can be heard. The game room reopened on Friday, January 17, 2014, and continues daily operation. The cycle of defiance will continue unabated unless this Temporary Restraining Order issues before the Temporary Injunction Hearing. The illegal gambling will not stop at this location until injunctive relief is granted.

For these reasons, the court ORDERS the following:

4. Defendant, Golden Star Business, LLC, its managers, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons acting in concert with them be restrained from:

- a. engaging in organized criminal activity;
- b. maintaining the premises at 5715 Airline Drive, Houston, Harris County, Texas as a place where persons go for the purpose of gambling or the promotion of gambling;
- c. allowing persons to enter 5715 Airline Drive for the purpose of gambling; or
- d. operating the game room without posting the following sign in black ink on a white background in one inch letters at every entrance:

**This Game Room is Under Court**

**Order to Prohibit Gambling**

**Violations may cost up to \$10,000, and**


**30 days in Jail**

5. The clerk shall issue notice to each named defendant, that the hearing on plaintiff's request for temporary injunction is set for Feb. 3, 2014, at 3:30 a.m./p.m.

6. The State is not required to post bond. Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 6.001.
