

Notice of Adopted 2016 Tax Rate

Harris County ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 2.36 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$-0.47.

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Harris County conducted public hearings on October 4, 2016 and October 11, 2016 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Harris County from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 1.70 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.41923 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$1,675,078,342.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.41656 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$1,689,288,951.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 7.99 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$1.25.

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Harris County Flood Control District conducted public hearings on October 4, 2016 and October 11, 2016 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Harris County Flood Control District from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 6.67 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.02733 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$105,963,155.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.01342 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$52,176,128.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.01334 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$53,168,130.
