General Information for Dental Services:

- Medicaid: 6 months - 20 years
- CHIP: 1 year - 18 years
- WIC: Dental appointments for WIC children can be made by presenting a current WIC Shopping List; mothers/legal guardians of WIC children are eligible for one dental visit.
- City Dental Card (sliding scale fee): 6 months - 21 years of age who do not have Medicaid, CHIP, or WIC; and pregnant women through 90 days post-partum. For info on how to obtain a City Dental Card: 832-393-3819
